Cubbies Camp (Ages 4-6)

Our Cubbies Camp is designed for our youngest campers. Campers will spend their days in a safe and fun environment where they will play a variety of exciting and age-appropriate games, and sports, along with arts & crafts, story-time and other creative activities. Due to a varying camp schedule, single day participants may not experience all of the above activities.

FC Stars Soccer (Ages 6-12)

The FC Stars Soccer Camp is designed to help make your son or daughter a better soccer player. Whether your child is a beginner or experienced player, this program will help improve their skills through individual technical development and small-sided games. Coached by FC Stars of Mass.

Soccer Camp is a half-day camp (9am-noon) with a full-day option.

Weeks offered: Week 3, Week 5, Week 9, Week 11

Fees: \$190 per week (Soccer Camp ONLY: 9am-noon)

\$290 per week (Soccer w/Sports Camp: 9am-4pm)

Basketball (Ages 6-12)

Our basketball camp will teach your child the fundamentals of the game while placing an emphasis on sportsmanship, strategy and teamwork. The morning will concentrate on developing skills such as passing, dribbling, shooting, and defense. Campers will then spend their afternoons playing half-court and full-court scrimmages.

Flag Football (Ages 6-12)

Fees: \$290 per week


Outdoor Adventures (Ages 8-13)



What Do We Need From Families Before They Have Some Fun At TEAMWORKS?

- 1. Paperwork All TEAMWORKS paperwork must be completed and submitted to the office one week prior to attending camp (forms are available online). Per Board of Health regulations, no child is allowed to attend camp until this paperwork is submitted.
- 2. TEAMWORKS Membership Card All campers must have a valid TEAMWORKS Membership (\$15) — Available online!!

The Facility

Perfect for Rain or Shine! TEAMWORKS Acton is a multi-functional facility that offers year-round recreational activity inside and out. We have six total fields (four indoor and two outdoor) along with a CATZ Training facility, outdoor climbing tower, heated pool, restaurant, and party zone!

The Staff

The TEAMWORKS Acton staff consists of experienced, talented, and dedicated people who truly enjoy working with children. We have a genuine interest in providing a fun and safe place for kids to be themselves. Our staff is certified in first aid and CPR, and are trained for specialty programs like the challenge course. All TEAMWORKS Acton staff receive a thorough background check, including three written references, CORI's, and SORI's. The child-to-staff ratio for our camp is 5:1 for our youngest campers and 10:1 throughout all other TEAMWORKS camps.

General Information

- TEAMWORKS is licensed by the local Board of Health
- To ensure camper safety, TEAMWORKS has strict sign-in and pick-up policies. Please familiarize yourself with these policies before your first day of camp to avoid any confusion.
- Pool time is available to all campers, even if they are off site.
- Campers are required to bring their own equipment for sport specialty camps (a list of suggested items for each camp is available on our website).
